South Georgia Ballet

South Georgia Ballet is a regional ballet company founded by Artistic Director Alison Bundrick in 1998 designed to provide additional training and challenging performing opportunities necessary for the development of future professional dancers. The Company has over 50 auditioned dancers from ages 9 - 18 who perform three productions each season. The goal of South Georgia Ballet's performance company is also to help create and nurture a thriving arts community in our area. We are committed to enhancing the quality of cultural and educational experiences available to all citizens.

SGB strives to reach out to bring classical ballet and a live performance experience to those who may not ordinarily have an opportunity to attend a professional quality production. We extend our "classroom" to the public through lecture demonstrations and mini-performances. Our outreach matinees bring an abbreviated production of The Nutcracker and each spring ballet to non-traditional audiences including children's groups and senior citizens. Partnerships with the Grady County Schools, the Marguerite Neel Williams Boys and Girls Club, the YMCA, and the Thomasville Resource Center bring weekly dance instruction and summer experiences to at-risk children.



Touring Company

South Georgia Ballet is available to tour regionally, bringing ballet to a wide area of the southeast. The Company has performed full-length productions in Baxley, Moultrie and Thomasville and has appeared in a variety of festivals and regional community events. This year the Company will tour *Ribbons and Strings: An Evening of Music, Dance and Art* to Thomasville Thursday, September 24. This collaboration with the Thomasville Cultural Center will feature a variety of dance styles with live instrumental accompaniment.
